ELIGIBILITY & LICENCES

Open to any rider within the UK. Anyone not holding a full ACU Licence will need to purchase a day licence.

Entries will be accepted from International licence holders subject to the production of a Start Permission and confirmation of FIM insurance cover. Licences must be produced when signing on.

Day licences and RHL club membership are available for rider's resident within the UK and can be obtained in the Licence Office at a cost of £10.00 per competitor. The licences will be issued on the day of the event in the Licence Office.

RIDER TICKET ELIGIBILITY

They are event only tickets.

SIGNING ON

Signing on will take place between 9.00am & 5.00pm on Friday 7th October 2011 in the Race Office on the seafront. **Youth riders only** will be allowed to sign on between 7.30 and 8.15am on Saturday 8th October 2011 if they cannot make it on Friday.

If a one event licence is required must be purchased for £10 in the Licence Office prior to signing on.
IMPORTANT - You must sign on prior to scrutineering to obtain a control card.

TECHNICAL CONTROL

Scrutineering will take place between 9.00am & 5.00pm on Friday 7th October 2011 in the entrance to Parc Ferme. Youth riders will be allowed between 7.30 am and 8.15am on Saturday 8th October 2011 if they cannot make it on Friday. **You will be required to bring your helmet and boots.** After this the machine will be placed in the secure parc ferme ready for the race. Only 1 person will be allowed in with the machine and **once it is in you will not be allowed back until the day of the race.** The parc ferme will be closed at 6.00pm. For the competitors benefit and a request from the police you are kindly asked to put your frame and engine number on your entry form.

Chain Guards – If the primary transmission is exposed, it must be fitted with a guard as a safety measure.
 All sidecars and Quads must be fitted with cut outs.

There will be no scrutineering for adults Saturday or Sunday so please do not enter the event if you cannot get your machine there on the Friday.

CLASSIFICATION OF A FINISHER

All competitors completing one lap will be included in the result. The closure of the timing system will be 30 minutes after the winner has crossed the line after the race duration has been completed.

FINISHING THE RACE

The Race will be finished with a Chequered Flag after the completed duration

CHANGE OF PASSENGER OR MACHINE

This will be permitted provided that an application in writing is made to the Clerk of the Course by 9.00am on Saturday 8th October 2011.

REMOVAL OF LAMPS

Direction indicators and wing mirrors must be removed. Other glass and plastic lenses must be taped.

SOUND CONTROL

The maximum sound level is 96 dBA for 2 stroke machines and 94dBA for 4 stroke machines, (based on the static test method)

REFUELLING

This will take place in a defined area. Under no circumstance will refuelling be allowed to take place at any other point. The penalty for disregarding this regulation will be immediate exclusion from the race. In line with Local Authority guidelines only BSI approved 5ltr fuel cans we be allowed in the refuelling area. Under no circumstances must fast filler fuel cans be used and anyone caught using them will be excluded immediately. Jerry cans of petrol are permitted for storage only. Engines must be stopped when refuelling.

No Children under 16 allowed in the Refuelling area other than Competitors.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

ACU stamped helmets must be used along with complete protective clothing produced for Motocross.

Riders and Passengers must wear knee length boots and gloves. It is advised that all participants wear a body/kidney belt and protective armour.

ELECTRONIC TIMEKEEPING

You will need an electronic transponder timing device to compete and all enquiries in connection with this are to be referred to our timing company at the address on the front of this form, under important information and contacts.

REFUNDS

Refunds will only be given with **Doctors Medical Documentation**. There will be a forfeit of 50% and notification and supporting documentation must be received no later than 26th September 2011 (postmark as proof).

NO REFUNDS WILL BE AUTHORISED AND ISSUED AFTER THIS DATE.

Motorsport is a dangerous event. If the event is cancelled or otherwise changed for reasons that are beyond RHL Activities Ltd reasonable control including, but without limitation, compliance with any law or governmental order, accident, rule or restrictions, adverse weather, fire, disease, war or terrorist activity, commotion, acts of God, strikes or other industrial action, breakdown of plant, machinery or any failure of gas, water service, electricity or similar supplies, then RHL Activities Ltd shall in such circumstances have no liability to the entrant. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

I acknowledge that I shall be competing in a physically demanding, hazardous and dangerous Event and that I am aware of the associated medical and physical risks involved in as a result of my participation in the Event.

I voluntarily assume the risks resulting from my competing in the Event and agree that I shall not make any claims or bring any actions or proceedings against the Organiser (and its affiliated companies, servants, officers and agents) [and/or any third party connected with the Event (including any other competitors)] in connection with my competing in the Event or otherwise in connection with the Event.

I am in an appropriate physical condition to participate in the Event and I shall not compete in the Event: (i) whilst under the influence of alcohol, drugs, medication (prescribed or otherwise) and/or any other substance; or (ii) if suffering any ailment or injury or being of a medical condition, whereby, in the case of (i) and (ii) the same may impair my physical abilities, judgement, mobility and/or otherwise increase the risk of me or any other person suffering an injury and/or fatality by my competing in the Event unless I have first brought obtained the Organiser's prior written approval to my participation, after having made a full and honest disclosure to the Organiser of the details of my condition.

I shall wear appropriate clothing and use appropriate safety equipment at all times whilst I am competing in the Event.

I shall compete in a manner that shows due regard for my safety and that of my fellow competitors and any other attendees of the Event.

I have ensured that my vehicle for the Event is safe, well maintained and fit for the Event and the nature of the circuit/track/course.

I agree that the Organiser's liability is limited in that it shall not be responsible for any indirect, consequential or economic losses arising due to my participation in the Event.

I acknowledge that if I want insurance of any kind, I must obtain my own. I will pay my own medical emergency expenses and all subsequent medical expenses in the event of any illness, accident, or injury in connection with the Event.

Parent/Guardian Consent for Competitors under the age of 18 years
